Please remember that ALL rehearsals and performances are graded events that are part of the class. A student's ability to be prepared and focused also contributes to the grade. Any time the student is missing band supplies-flip folder, drill book, instrument, water jug etc. or fails to dress properly, the grade is affected. Additionally, <u>non fall sport athletes who miss after-school rehearsal time are required to make up this time before they will be permitted to perform</u>. With the exception of fall sport athletes, any student who misses a Thursday rehearsal from 5-8 will be ineligible to perform on Friday night. This policy is necessary because there isn't time for a student to make-up three hours of rehearsal before the game.
