Please remember that ALL rehearsals and performances are graded events that are part of the class. A student's ability to be prepared and focused also contributes to the grade. Any time the student is missing band supplies-flip folder, drill book, instrument, water jug etc. or fails to dress properly, the grade is affected. Additionally, non fall sport athletes who miss after-school rehearsal time are required to make up this time before they will be permitted to perform. With the exception of fall sport athletes, any student who misses a Thursday rehearsal from 5-8 may be ineligible to perform on Friday night. This policy is necessary because the band typically learns new material on Thursdays that cannot be learned before the performance.

Tickets for home football games will be available online at teaysvalleyathletics.com. You must have an account and a credit/debit card to purchase tickets. There is a season ticket available that will save you money in service fees if you choose that option. You can purchase single game tickets at the stadium gate, but again, you must do so using a credit/debit card. No cash is accepted.

Fall Sport Athlete/Band Members
