Reminder: All students will have one sectional and one full band rehearsal (Thursdays) after school. Students typically stay after school. Most students bring a light snack. On Thursdays, everyone will have a required music check before rehearsal starts. A reminder: **Anyone who misses after school rehearsal time is required to make up that time before they are permitted to perform. Students must schedule this time with a student leader from their section.**

Please remember that ALL rehearsals and performances are graded events that are part of the class. A student's ability to be prepared and focused also contributes to the grade. Any time the student is missing rehearsal supplies-flip folder, drill book, instrument, flag water jug etc. or fails to dress properly, the grade is affected. Thursday night rehearsal absences may result in the student being unable to perform on Friday because there isn't time to make up the hours that are missed.

Uniform Expectations: Thin shorts underneath band pants, uniform shirt, navy blue long sleeves, no turtlenecks, socks must be long, plain black-no logos and clean band shoes. HAIR: Cannot touch your collar, eyes or ears, guys clean shaven, no rings, no visible necklaces, no jewelry, no earrings, no bracelets, no visible piercings (watches are permitted) Nail Polish must be clear or light pink. BRING SUMMER UNIFORM just in case. (Dark Belt and Khaki Shorts)
4:45pm	Inspection: BAND WATER JUG with ice/water. Half-dressed with instrument, flip folder and water jug. Coat on hanger with garment bag around hanger. Hat in box. Instrument in case. Flip Folder in box. (If we decide to wear summer uniform, you will be completely dressed.)

Music Checks

The music check grade contributes to the overall band grade, and students will be assessed on a variety of musical elements (tone, intonation, notes, rhythms, articulations, musicianship, etc.) in addition to their memorization. In addition to the grade being affected, failure to pass assigned music checks may prohibit students from earning the third quarter break at football games. **Music Check Schedule: Part 1-2: The Intro/Opener** music check was due **8/13**. The music check for Part 1 of *The Ballad* was due **8/20**. **Part 2 of The Ballad is due 8/27. Grades for Part 1-3 of the Contest Show become final on 9/4. Color Guard work checks are final 9/10. The closer deadline is TBA.** The deadline for passing all **Pre-Game Music** is the Homecoming Game on Oct. 2. Students can re-attempt music checks from 4:30pm-5:00pm on their sectional day.

After School Rehearsal Make-Up Time Procedure

On occasion, students miss rehearsal after school. Again, any time an after school rehearsal is missed, the time missed must be made up. Make-up time activities are based on what the member missed at rehearsal and will include music or spinning and marching. The procedure for making up time is as follows: After a rehearsal is missed, the student must approach members of the leadership team in their section to ask to schedule make-up time for the student. (The time can be split up if needed.) Student leaders should rotate the make-up time duties. At the start of the make-up time, the student leader must check in with a staff member to let them know that time is being made up. At the end of the make-up time, the student leader will check out with the staff member. The staff member will log the make up time until the time is complete.

Important Upcoming Dates

Due to the holiday on September 7, there will be two full band rehearsals during this week. The first is Tuesday September 8 from 3-5pm followed by the regular full band rehearsal from 4-7pm on Thursday. These rehearsals are especially important due to the contest on September 12th.

School is also canceled for September 21, so we will have full band on 9/22 from 3-5pm. The stadium is available on 9/24 so we will rehearse in the stadium from 5-8pm. Please mark your calendars.

The September 12 Band Contest is at Licking Heights. Our performance time will be in the evening, but band families will need to reserve the entire day for rehearsal, travel, a sack dinner, official warm-up and awards. There is also a critique involving the staff and adjudicators following the awards, so our return will be slightly delayed. Don't forget that parents/legal guardians can sign-out band members at the bus after awards if needed.
